Only \$4 to enjoy a delicious treat that is Oh So Good! And Oh So Good For You!

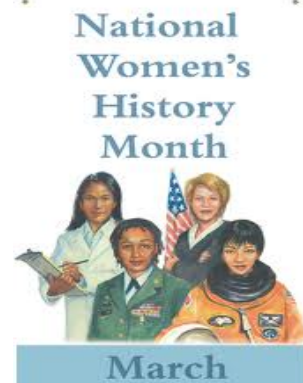

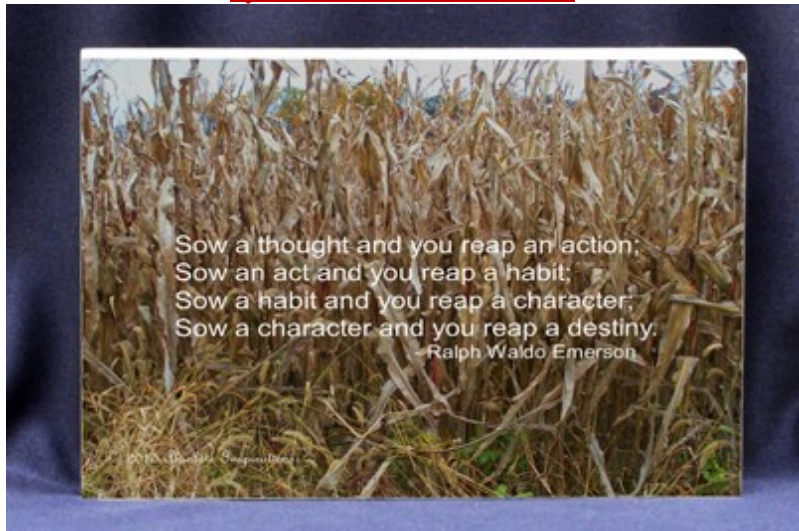

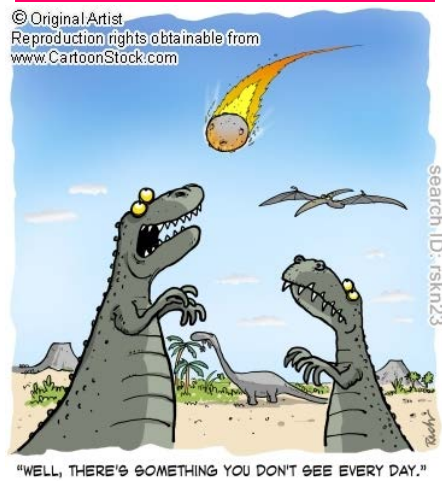
THIS DATE IN HISTORY

1765: The Stamp Act was enacted on the American colonies by Britain.
 1894: The first Stanley Cup championship game was played. The Montreal Amateur Athletic Association (won the cup unchallenged the previous year) triumphed over the Ottawa Capitals.
 1895: Auguste and Louis Lumiere first demonstrated motion pictures using celluloid film in Paris.
 1945: The Arab League was formed in Cairo, by Egypt, Iraq, Jordan, Lebanon, and Syria.
 1972: Congress approved the Equal Rights Amendment and sent it to be ratified by the states. The amendment would fail to get the required 38 states to ratify it.

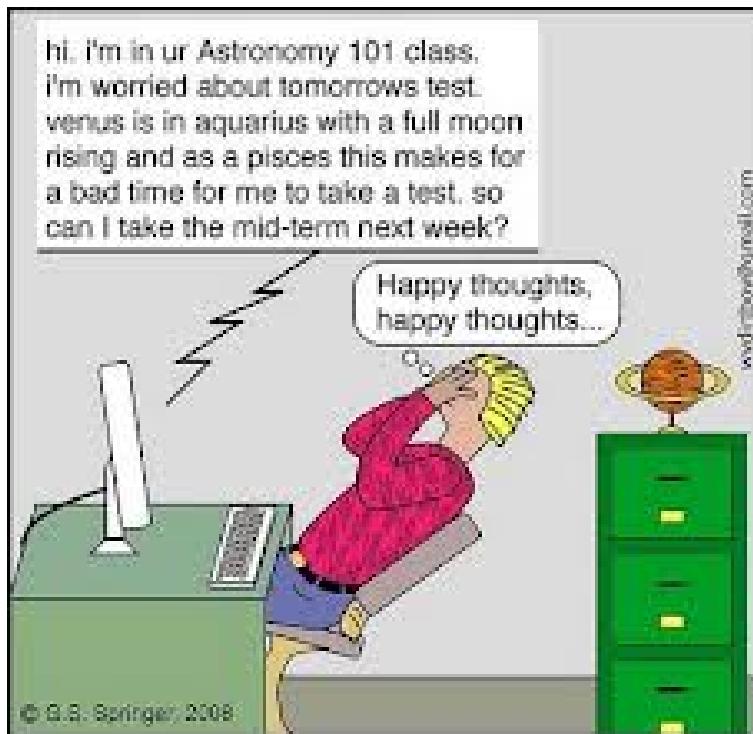
