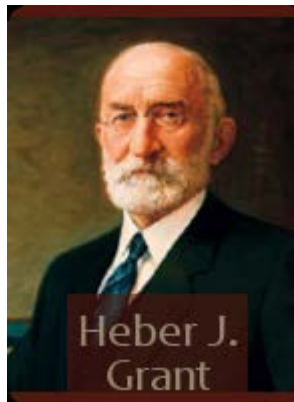
THIS DATE IN HISTORY

- 2000: Vladimir Putin was inaugurated as Russia's president.

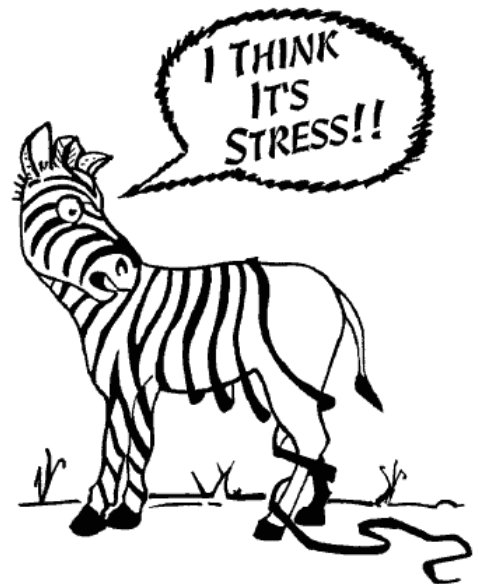

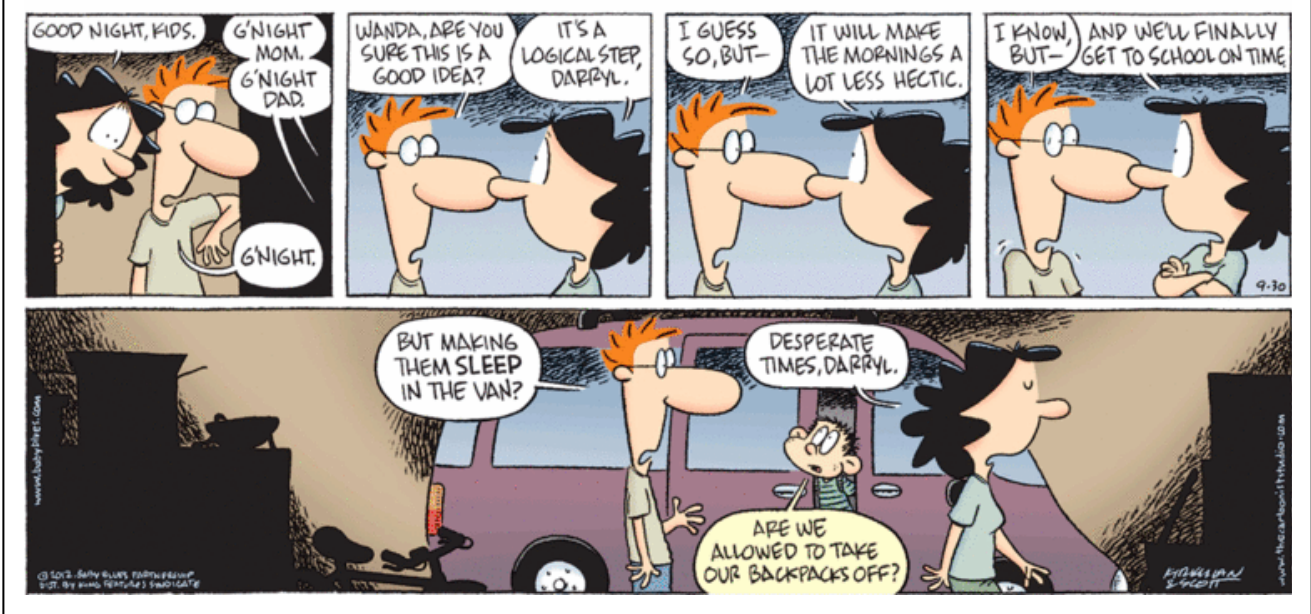
