BLACK HISTORY MONTH:

The Black Student Union is proud to feed your mind one day at a time for Black History Month. Make sure you listen carefully because there will be a trivia contest based on these facts at the end of the month. Your daily dose of history for today is: On February 12th:

Feb. 12, 1865 – Henry Highland Garnet first black to speak in the Capitol, delivered memorial sermon on the abolition of slavery at services in the House of Representatives.

Feb. 2, 1909 - The National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP) was founded. The call for the organizational meeting was issued on 100th anniversary of Abraham Lincoln's birth by 47 whites and 6 blacks.

Feb. 12, 1948 – First Lt. Nancy C Leftneant became the first black accepted in the regular Army Nursing Corps.
