Feb.14, 1817 – Frederick Douglas, “The Great Emancipator,” is born.

Feb. 14, 1867 – Morehouse College organized in Augusta, GA. The institution was later moved to Atlanta. New registration law in Tennessee abolished racial distinctions in voting.

Feb 14, 1936 – National Negro Congress organized a Chicago meeting attended by 817 delegates representing more than 500 organizations.
