YEARBOOK:

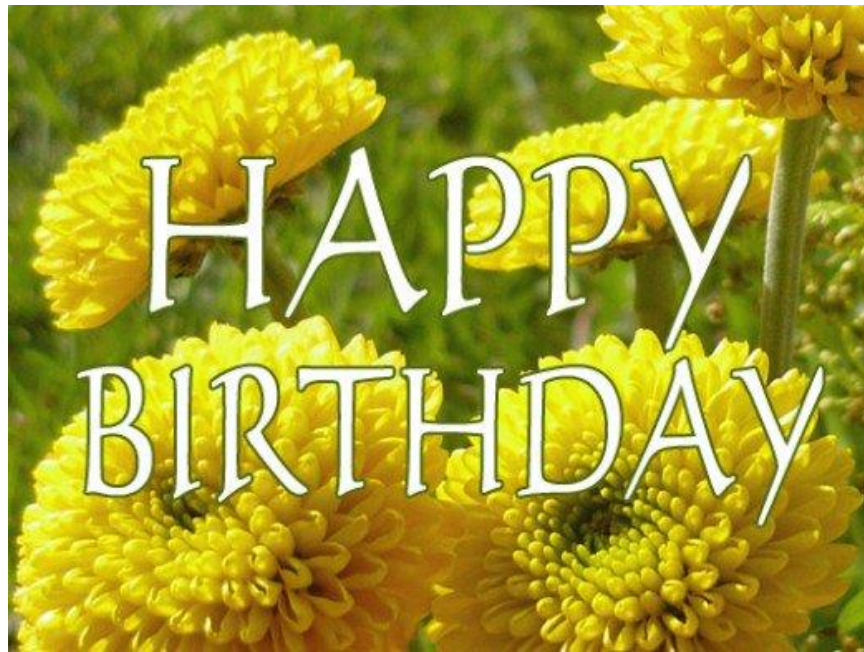
