## **MIT CESAR CHAVEZ DAY CELEBRATION – ART CONTEST:**

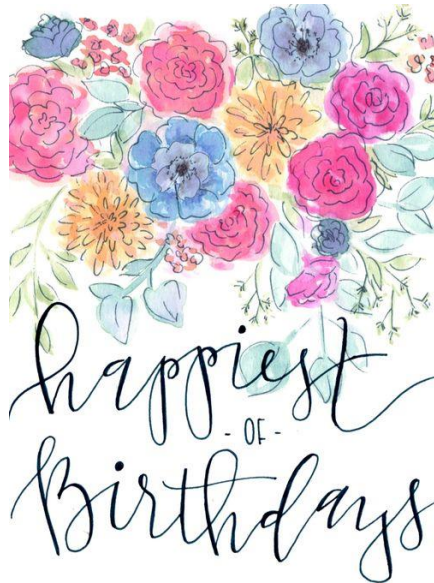
