AVID applications are now available for students in **6th – 10th grade!**

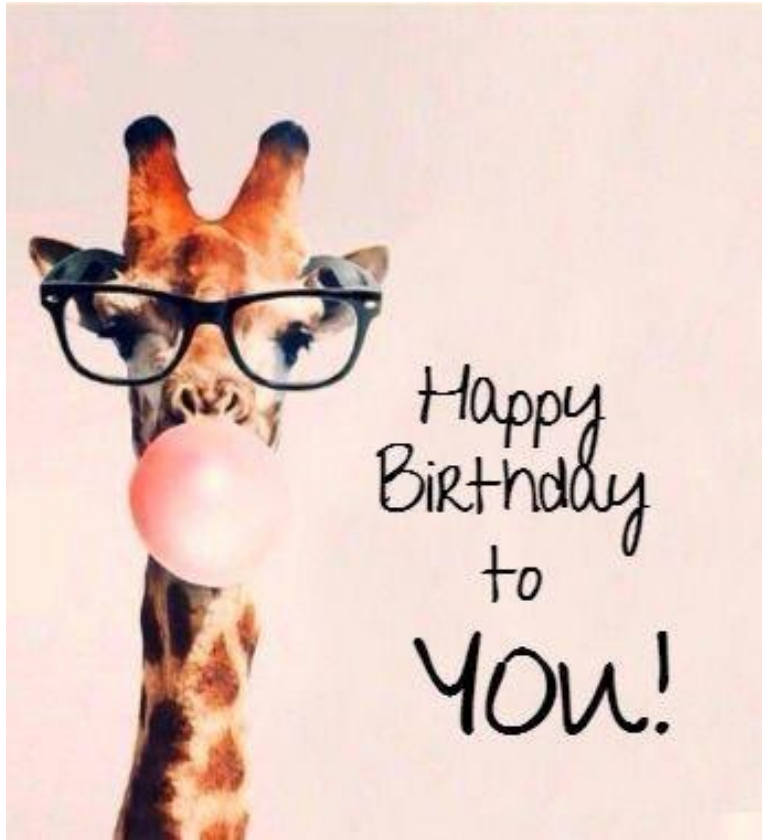
- The **AVID** program's primary focus is to support students in preparing for college.
