CANDY LEIS:

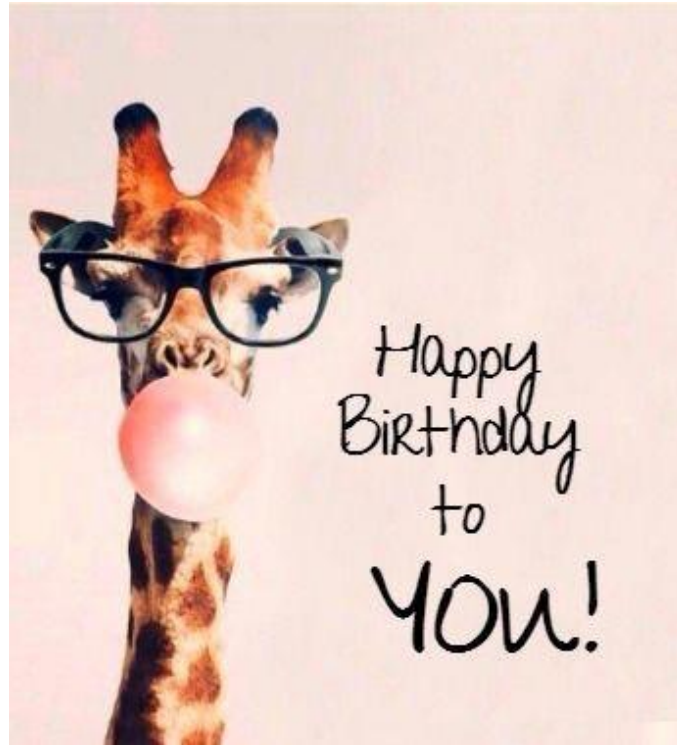
