TARDY POLICY:

Our tardy policy requires all students to **proceed directly to class** if you arrive to school **after the late bell and before 8:24 a.m.**

If a student arrives to school **at 8:24 a.m. or later**, they must check in at the Student Services Offices. **High schoolers** please to go **Room L** for a tardy pass. **Middle Schoolers** please go to **Room G1.5**. All late arrivals **must** check-in for a Tardy Pass at their respective Student Services Office.

SCHEDULE CHANGES:

To request a Schedule Change: Students, please pick-up a Schedule Change form from the Main Office. Students are not eligible for schedule changes due to teacher preference. Students are only eligible for schedule changes if they have an incorrect course. High Schoolers turn in your completed forms in room J. Middle Schoolers turn in your completed forms in room G1.5 to Ms. Feller. Request forms need to be turned in by **no later than Wednesday, August 28th**.
