AFTERSCHOOL TUTORING:

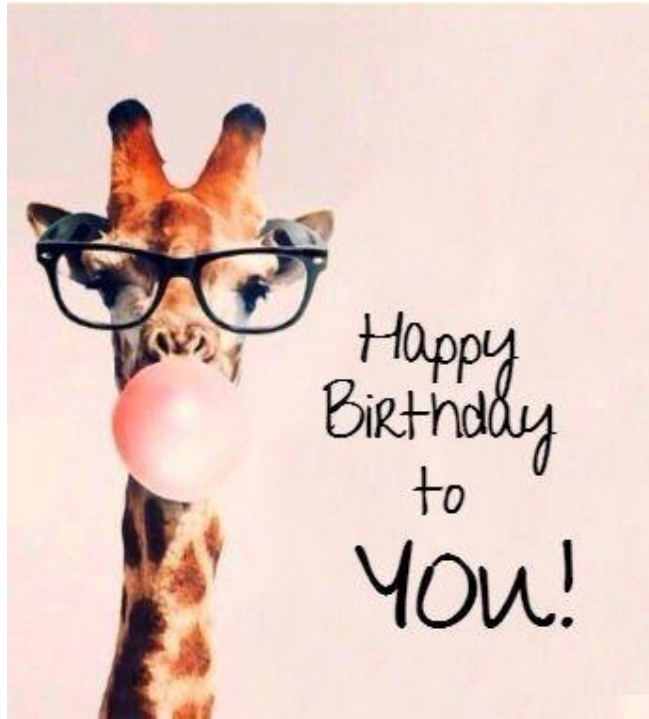
After school tutoring is held in Ms. Stennett's classroom Room A5, Mondays-Fridays, from 4:00 pm to 6:00 pm.
