The MIT Gaming Club meets daily in room EV-2 during HS lunch, and meets after-school every Wednesday & Friday, from 4-6.

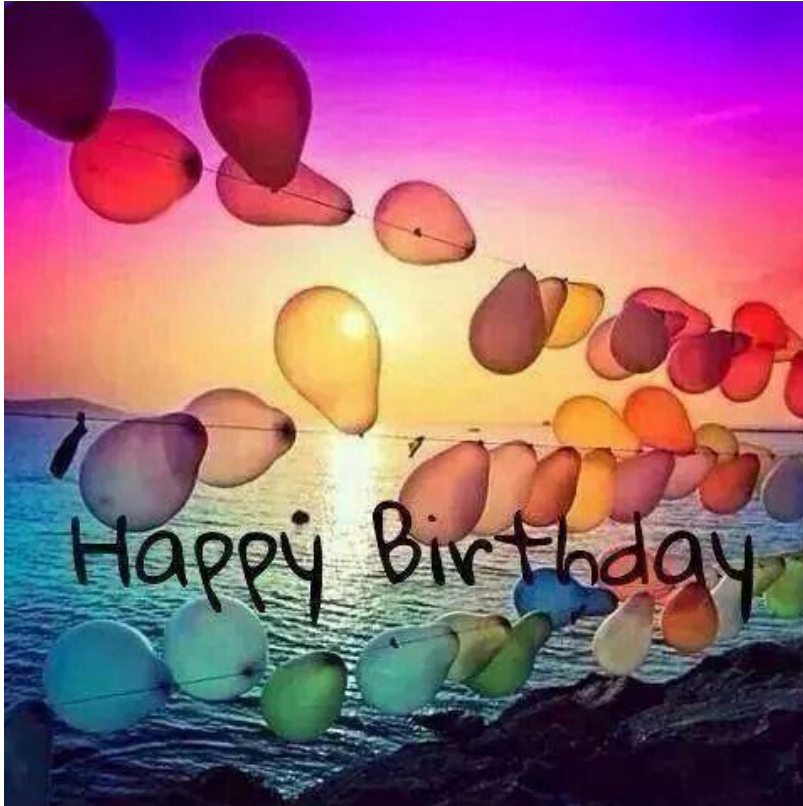
**AFTERSCHOOL TUTORING:**
