When arriving on campus to fulfill your Volunteer Hours during the work week >>>

- First go to the Main Office H1 ½ , sign-in in the Parent Volunteer Binder, and let the office know where you will be working.
- Then get an MITA Volunteer Hours Slip and a Sticker, and please make sure to complete the following:
 - Volunteer name.
 - Student name and grade.
 - Date and time you arrived; then when done, the time you finished working.
 - Description of what you did.
 - Signature from the staff member you helped.
- Return to the Main Office H1 ½ to sign out for the day and have an office staff initial your Volunteer hour slip.
- When completed, the slip will be placed in a locked wooded box. This will then be processed by the Parent Volunteer Coordinator.
- Note: The office does not make copies of slips or gives receipts. Please keep records of when/what you have contributed in case of discrepancies.

When arriving to fulfill your Volunteer Hours for Saturday Work Crew >>>

- The first 20 volunteers will be accepted.
- Check in by the Green Maintenance Fence with Rene Bartolome.
- Rene will then let you know what work is assigned for that Saturday & he will provide you an MITA Volunteer Hours Slip. Please make sure to complete the following:
 - Volunteer name.
 - Student name and grade.
 - Date and time you arrived.
- Once you have completed the first three sections Rene will take the slips & keep them until you are done for the day.
- When you have finished, Rene will then hand back the slip and you will finish completing the following:
 - Time you finished working
 - Description of what you did
- Once you have finished filling out the Volunteer Hours Slip, Rene will then sign off on your slip to show you were on campus.
- The following Monday morning, Rene will then turn in all documents to the Parent Volunteer Coordinator.

When you complete all of your Parent Volunteer Hours >>>

- You will receive a Certificate letting you know you completed your hours.
- If you have an overage of hours:
 - You can donate the overage of hours to friends or families in need. (Please contact the Parent Volunteer Coordinator to make arrangements.)
 - They are not carried over to the following year.

How to track your Volunteer Hours >>>

- You can check your Volunteer Hours via the website at <http://www.mitacademy.org>.
- You will need your child's student number to look up your Volunteer Hours. Call Coordinator for assistance.
- To ensure an accurate account for your hours, please turn in your slips when you complete your task!
- You should keep a calendar or other such item record of what you have done / donated.
